INTRODUCTION

The United Rural Development Service (URDS) is a purely non-political, non-sectarian and non-profit making organisation. The organization has been contributing a major share role of implementation for the Welfare and Development and participation of the people of Manipur for hill and plain areas.

It was established on 25th February, 1992 and its head office is situated at Heirok Village in Thoubal District, Manipur. The main objective of the organization is in the largest in view of making up economically and environmentally development in the weaker sections in the surrounding village. The areas are poor villages situated in eastern boundary of Thoubal district next to Chandel (Hilly region) District in state of Manipur.

The United Rural Development Service (URDS) was registered on 30th April in the year, 1993 under the Societies Registration Act 1989 (Manipur act 1 of 1990) vide Registration No. 105 of 1993

URDS has been working in the field of Health, Agriculture, Sports, Women and Child Welfare services, Education, Rural Development Services, Socio-economic, Training, Rehabilitation and welfare programme for aged, handicapped, orphans, women and child labour etc. since its inception in different parts of the state.

The activities of the society are carried out by an executive committee which regular and institution of the society.

Vision

The vision of the United Rural Development Service is Upliftment of rural masses, healthy people, quality education, cultural & socio-economical development.

Mission

Its mission is Dictication and sacrifice for the community specially for youth women, children , poor& distitute to create a healthy and strong nation.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- a) To run and maintain vocational Training Centre, Rural Health Care, Orphanage Home, Residential School, Small Scale Industries Units, Aged Home Centre, Rehabilitation Centre for Drug Addict, Handicapped /Women & Child Labour, Family Welfare Centre Working Women Hostel, Library and Information Centre, Hostel for Working Women , Library and Information Centre, Dairy,Pigery farms, Poultry farm etc. for development and upliftment and standard of living of the rural masses and standard .
- b) To involve the youth of different walks of life to take part in the Welfare and Development activities, social service, protection of environment and trained them in activities leading of self employment and different rural development services.
- c) To explore and train local leaders and involve in local development activities. To construct Low Cost Rural Housing for those who are living on BPL.
- d) To uplift the agricultural development programmes and cultural workshop programmes.
- e) To take up various welfare activities in the backward remote area including SC/ST people of the rural area and hill areas in the State for the up bringing and all round development.
- f) Introduction Innovative Environmental Education in School.
- g) To rise funds by receiving donation, contribution fees from local bodies.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE URDS FOR THE YEAR, 2018-2019

1. Residential School of Scheduled Tribe Children

The Residential School for Scheduled tribe children had been set up by the United Rural Development Service(URDS), Heirok, Manipur in the year 2000 with the financial assistance from the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi (Tribal Development Division) from Class-I to Class-V(Primary School) As the organisation is situated at nearby scheduled tribe villages of hilly areas, namely, Heinoukhong, Thamlai, Machi, Marryland, Karongthel, Leirongthel, Wabaching, Paringtong, etc. The villages are so much economically backwards areas of scheduled tribe villages and situated a long distance from high way and poor communication areas. The name of the school titled as "Advance Learner School (Residential)". As per guidelines of the ministry there are 100 children from different Scheduled Tribe villages. All children in the school, have been provided free fooding and lodging facilities in the school boarding. They have also been provided free outing ,medicine,uniform, cultural , sports facilities etc. There are 23 teaching and non teaching staff .

The school has been recognised by the Board of Secondary School, Manipur to open upto class-X since 2005 , uder recognition No. 1/54/01/2291.

There are three sets of Uniforms viz, two white colour of shirts for boys and girls, one coffee and one white colour of pants for boys and frocks for girls each provided for the children. Text books are distributed at the beginning of classes and statiiionery, in every month or whichever necessary by the children.

.The organisation provides two *break first* at 7 a.m. and 6 p.m., two lunches at 9 a.m. and 8 p.m. for the children every day. Regular health check-up for the all children are being provided. The nurse and ayaas look after the children carefully of their study and health and nutrition.

As usual other co-curricular activities also have been organised namely, the Annual Sports & Cultural Meet in the month of March, Annual Educational /Internal Excursion in the month of June, , Painting Competition ,Teachers Day cum Prize Distribution in September, etc.

Educational / Internal Excursion:

The Advance Learner School(Residential),Heirok organisid the Annual Educational/Internal Excursion 2018-19 on 14th June 2018. There were 94 students with staff of this school participated in the Excursion. The places where the students visited were, State Musium Imphal, Khuman Lampak Sports Complex, Imphal,Kangla, Science Centre, Botanical Garden (Zoo), Iroishemba, Singda Dam, Maphou Dam (Thoubal Multipurposed Project, Loukoipat (Tourist Home), Sendra Tourist Home,MM Unity Park-Khangabok, Khongjom War Memorial etc.

The journey was started at 10 a.m. and arrived at first at Khonjom War Memorial. Every year on 23rd April, the anneversiry function as “Khonjom Day” observed at the place. It is a historical place of patriotism in Manipur. In Aglo War,1981, many patriotic heroes of Manipur contributed their lives for land of Manipur. This is the immortable and inspiration to the children and students in their future .

Next the students visited at the MM Unity Park, Khangabok which is a beautiful unique scenerio and folk traditional articles in the park. Then the Kangla Fort was seen by the students. This place was occupied by Assam Rifle for a long period and took over to the people of Manipur recently. This indicates different statues of historical kingdom of Manipur, holy places, etc. Then visited at State Musium. Here there are so many articles, like like articles used by Khamba, Khamnu, Thoibi of Moirang Kangleiol and other histotical articles, etc. The Khuman Lampak Sport Complex is the only stadium of sports in the state of Manipur was visited and seen the different discipline /events statdiums in the complex.

The team were visited at Maphou Dam under the Thoubal Multipurposed Project which is the largest dam in Manipur. Then the students arrived at Science Musium and Botanical Garden (zoo) at Iroisemba. After seen the zoo, the journey left there for Loukoipat (Tourist centre), Bisnumpur and Sendra tourist centre. About 6 p.m. the journey was concluded and returned to the school. Thus the annual educational and internal excursion of the school was conducted with good successful



2. Senor Citizen Home

The ***Senor Citizen Home*** which run by the United Rural Development Service (URDS), Heirok, Thoubal District, Manipur, at Heirok Heituppokpi with 25 aged destituted old aged persons from different villages has been implemented smoothly. The centre has been running under the financial assistance from the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, New Delhi.

The centre provides free cost of fooding , lodging ,medicines and recreational items with outing to the inmates. Medical health check-up of the aged persons are done frequently in a month. Daily newspaper , comics, journal, etc are maintained to them. Slates, chalks, pencils, exercise books, primary books etc. also provided for as an adult literacy. During the summer season , the folk tale programme (traditional programme for the aged persons in the state) has been organised in every year.

As usual, in this year, the outing programme was conducted on 17th May ,2018 and the spots were at holly places of Govindaji Temple-Imphal, Kaina Temple and Mondum Mahadeva.



3. Public Library cum Information Centre

A Public Library cum Information Centre is there in campus of the United Rural Development Service, Heirok. There are about 10,700 number of different books in the library. Different subject of reference and text books like , Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Botany, Mathematics, Geography, History, Civics & Economics, Political Science, Literature in different languages, Children Books, Medicinal Books, Agricultural Books, etc. in the library. Daily-Local Newspaper of 5 kinds , Telegraphs, Employment News, Weekly Journals and others are there in the library. The organisation provides two staff - one Librarian and another Assistant Librarian to look after and administrate the library for smooth running. Their salary has been borne by the organisation in the largest interest of the readers.

The trainers/resource persons gave speeches mainly on the topics- Definition, Decision making of leadership- types of decision,management, Leadership style, Leadership & power, Gender & Leadership, TTeam Versus Group, etc.

Free Health Care Camp for School Children

Two doctors and three nurses of the Community Health Centre Heirok were engaged for the health camp.

There are about 300 school children were taken health check-up during tyhe camp.

4 Days Workshop on NREGS

The United Rural Development Service Heirok organised the 4-Day Workshop on NREGS at Salungpham Village. About the facilities provided on NRGS to the villagers, nature of the job, i.e., job for themselves ,etc.were made discussion during the workshop.

Agri & Horticulture Dev. Programme

As a part of the development programme on agriculturtal. and horticultural activities for the rural farmers, the United Rural Development service, organised a farmers' traing programme and distributed seed and nurseru plants to the farmers. *Page-8/-*

During the programme, the resource persons gave lectures on the useful technique/technologies, method and applicable measures, for successful farmers on agricultural works as well as horticultural activities. After completion of the programme, the organisation

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distributed ginger seeds, peas, potato seeds, nursery of banana, lemon, mango trees, etc.to the 45 farmers on free of cost.

Skill Development Programme:-

The United Rural Development Service, Heirok has organised Skill Development Programme at the Organisation's training hall from 10th to 20th October, 2018. During the programme, 20 carpenters were participated and gave training for upgradation of their skill on furniture works.

The participants were from Heirok ,Salungpham and Kairembikhok village who are practising on the furniture works. To give added more knowledge and make fully skill on their works with modern and scientific practice, it would make a more development to their works. New models, designs, techniques of furniture works were given training to the participated carpenters.
